## 2023 Scholarships Awarded Through Hanover Education Foundation

**Alex Moore Scholarship** - \$1,000 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior from Hanover High School having a GPA of 3.0, planning to attend a four year college, and having demonstrated positive leadership and citizenship skills.

**ASBO Eagle Student Scholarship** – \$2,750 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior who will be attending a four year college.

**Ashland Garden Club Scholarship** – \$2,000 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior from Patrick Henry High School who will be attending a four year college.

**Atlee Raiders Generations Scholarship** - \$2,000 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior from Atlee High School who will be attending a technical school, community, or military college or university.

**Austin Brown Pleasants Memorial Scholarship** – \$1,500 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior from Patrick Henry High School or PHHS senior attending The Hanover Center for Trades & Technology.

**Beth O'Brien Hubbard Memorial Scholarship** – \$1,000 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior from all four high schools and The Georgetown School having a GPA of 3.0 and who will enroll in a four-year college majoring in Business. The awardee should show positive work ethics and leadership skills.

**Bette J. Harmon Memorial Scholarship** – \$5,000 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior from Atlee High School and Mechanicsville High School who will enroll in a four-year college or university pursuing a degree in either English or Education. This scholarship is given in memory of Bette J. Harmon, a long time librarian in Hanover County Public Schools.

**Bodie and Faye Memorial Art Scholarship** – Two \$1,000 scholarships awarded to graduating seniors from Patrick Henry High School majoring in Art.

**Bootsie Thomas Memorial Scholarship** – Two \$1,000 scholarships awarded to a graduating male and female athlete from Mechanicsville High School.

**Charles Frederick League Scholarship** – Two \$1,000 scholarships awarded to a graduating senior from Mechanicsville High School and Hanover High School pursuing a degree in Education and possibly wanting to coach.

Clay & Christine Overbey Virginia Tech Scholarship – \$500 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior from Patrick Henry High School who will be attending Virginia Tech pursuing a degree in Agriculture or related studies.

**Clay Springs Ruritan Club Scholarship** – Two \$1,000 scholarships awarded to a graduating senior from Hanover High School and Patrick Henry High School.

**Derek Crytser Memorial Scholarship** - \$1,500 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior from Hanover High School and Atlee High School who will be pursuing a post-high school education at either a two year or four year college. This scholarship is given in memory of Derek Crytser who graduated from Hanover High School.

**Doswell Limited Partnership, LLC** – One \$5,000 scholarship for a female graduating from Patrick Henry High School pursuing a degree in a STEM program.

**Eleanor J. Sydnor Honor Award** – Two \$1,500 scholarships awarded to graduating seniors from Patrick Henry High School majoring in Education. This scholarship was set up by the PHHS Class of 1942 and is given in memory of Miss Sydnor who taught English and Math at Henry Clay High School for 26 years.

**Hanover AARP Chapter Scholarship** - \$500 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior having a GPA of 3.0 or better, exhibited strong leadership and citizenship skills, and demonstrated a strong work ethic. This student will be pursuing a career in special education and/or the healthcare field.

**Henry Clay Elementary – Teresa M. Keck Scholarship** – One \$500 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior from Patrick Henry High School who attended Henry Clay Elementary School.

J. K. Samples Scholarship – Up to \$3,500 scholarship awarded to three graduating seniors from all four high schools. Mr. Samples served as the Superintendent of Hanover County Public Schools from 1965 -1980 and was committed to quality education for all students. It is in this spirit that the J.K. Samples Scholarship Fund was established. The J.K. Samples Scholarship, funded through the estate of Mr. Samples and his wife, is to be awarded to graduates of Hanover County Public Schools to assist with their post-high school education.

James Pierce "Punkie" Kegley, Jr., Memorial Scholarship – One \$500 scholarships awarded to a graduating senior from Patrick Henry High School having a GPA of 2.0 and with a desire to continue their post high school education in public service (i.e., EMS, firefighter, nurse, police).

**Kevin Ritz Memorial Scholarship** – \$1,500 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior from Mechanicsville High School who has an interest in pursuing a degree in Education. This scholarship is given in memory of Kevin Ritz, a 1988 graduate of Lee- Davis High School and University of Virginia.

**Kings Dominion Scholarship** - \$500 scholarship awarded to one graduating senior from each high school. Must be an existing or former Kings Dominion employee in good standing.

**Robert & Helen Parker Memorial Scholarship Fund** – \$5,000 scholarship awarded to fifteen graduating seniors from Patrick Henry High School that will be pursuing a degree in Medicine, Mathematics, Business, or Science.

**Rockville Ruritan Scholarship** - \$1,000 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior from Patrick Henry High School who is planning to attend a community college or trade school.

**Serve and Learn** - \$1,000 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior from each high school who demonstrated exceptional volunteerism in their community.

**Shane Adcock Memorial Scholarship** - \$500 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior from Atlee High School planning to attend a four year college or university with an interest in the military, healthcare, or public service.

**Superintendent's Future Educator Scholarship** – \$2,500 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior who will be attending a four year college with a desire to be a K-12 educator.

**The Efe Obrimah Memorial Scholarship** – \$1,000 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior from Atlee High School who will be attending a four year college.

**The Insurance Doctor Scholarship** – Two \$1,000 scholarships awarded to a graduating senior from Patrick Henry High School pursuing a post-high school degree.

**Wegmans Distribution Center Hanover County Public Schools Scholarship** – Eight \$1,000 scholarships awarded to two graduating seniors from each of the four high schools who exhibited strong leadership and participated in extracurricular activities.
